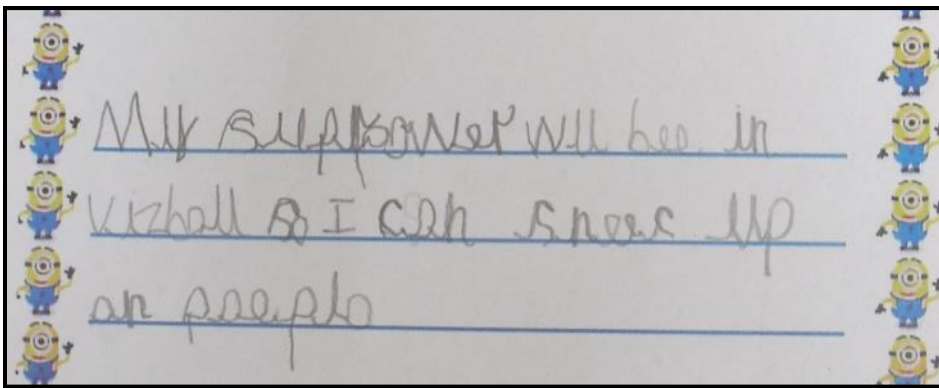




## VILLAINS BEWARE!!
