We will be going to the British Wildlife Centre on Monday 24th April. We will learn all about animals that we could find in our gardens. One of the animals that we see may become a main character in the stories we create.

We will be reading and learning about lots of different stories and thinking about the different characters, the different settings, the problems they may face and their solutions.




We will be retelling well known stories as well as our own stories through puppet shows, small world exploration and stage productions!



We will continue to our learning. **CAPTURE**
This half term we will be focusing on **Think**. For this learning skill we will be doing lots of thinking. Including thinking about what we can use to support us in our learning; thinking of new ideas; thinking of solutions and thinking of questions to ask.

We will continue to count, order and recognise numbers to 20, and developing our understanding of place value. We will continue to add and take away using different strategies, and applying what we know to solve problems. We will practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We are still working towards our math passport targets, please make sure they are in school every Friday.



We will be inspired to write our own stories by listening and discussing well known texts, exploring a box of possibilities, using story stones and looking at thought provoking pictures. When writing we will make sure our story has a beginning, middle and end.



This term we will be focusing on our Wray Common value of 'Kindness' and will think about all the different parts of our life and our school day we can show kindness to others.

In PSHE, we will be focusing on financial capability. We will talk what money is and how they can make choices about it.
