

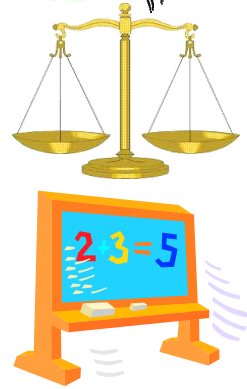

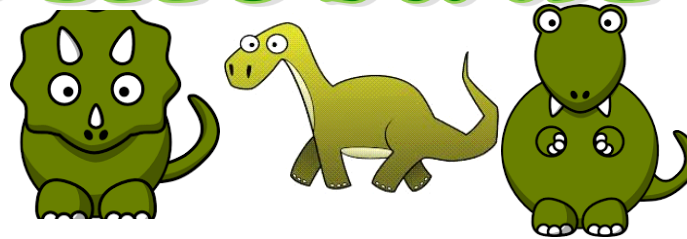
Reception Topic Web Jan-Feb 2018

We will be continuing to count carefully forwards and backward. Will begin to explore adding and subtracting. We will also be measuring height, length and weight.



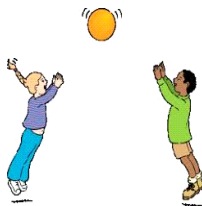
Dinosaurs

Don't forget your Legendary learning sheets for when your child amazes you at home with their learning.

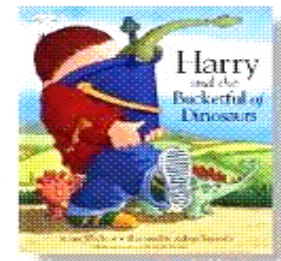
You could practise throwing and catching a ball at home; we will be learning how to do this during P.E.
