Areas of Learning

As mathematicians, we will be learning about graphs and times.

- Explore our own ecological consciences through the use of chosen English texts and discussions of our responsibilities.

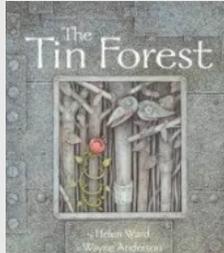
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Key Skills

English

As writers we will:

- Use precise vocabulary to support the purpose and show an awareness of the reader.
- Organise our writing through the use of time and place conjunctions.
- Develop our character by describing how they speak, behave and react.
- Write recount texts in the past tense, using a fictional stimulus.
- Develop our character by describing how they move.



Maths

As mathematicians we will:

- Continue to refine our mental and written methods for the four operations.
- Learn about 12 and 24 hour clock, convert between units of time and solve time problems.
- Learn about line graphs and develop our understanding of how to read them as well as creating our own

PE

We will:

- Practise how we will run, jump, throw and catch in isolation and together
- Play competitive games, in both attacking and defending positions

DT & Art

We will:

- Choose materials and techniques which are appropriate for a task.

- Talk about works of art and give reasons for our opinions.
- Develop our photography skills.

Geography & History

We will:

- Use maps to locate positions and geographical features.
- Express views on the features of an environment and the way it is being harmed or improved.
- Answer questions about geographical and environmental features.
- Give some reasons for particular events and changes.
- Gather information from simple sources
- Use our knowledge and understanding to answer simple questions about the past and changes.
- Use digital mapping to compare how our local areas has changed over time.

Computing

We will:

- Learn to enter data into a database.
- Search the data to answer questions
- Construct our own branching databases to support our study of habitats

Science

We will:

- Carry out simple investigations
- Investigate processes that have an effect on habitats
- Discover food chains in our local environment.
- Classify animals and plants

Music

We will:

- Explore music through the works of the English composer Benjamin Britten

We will:

- Find out how artefacts play a part in worship
- Look at the role of prayers, the bible and music in worship
