'WW2 Workshop'

On Tuesday 30th October, the children in Year 6 will be visited in school by 'Portals to the Past.' An experienced team will deliver a day full of WW2 related activities. This exciting experience will support the children's learning and be a stimulus for their writing next half term. To help the children get into the spirit of the day, we would like them to come to school dressed in WW2 related costume. Here are a few ideas:

Boys Clothing

- a cap, flat cap, balaclava, woollen scarf,
- white, grey or checked pattern shirt
- short trousers (boys didn't wear long trousers until they were teenagers!)
- jacket or blazer, cardigan or waistcoat (wool) or a sleeveless jumper
- grey socks and plimsolls or lace up leather shoes and a gas mask box

Girls Clothing

- woollen coat, jacket or blazer
- straw, felt or knitted hat and scarf
- cotton or woollen dress (girls did not wear trousers)
- woollen skirt and cotton blouse, woollen cardigan or sleeveless jumper
- ankle socks, grey or white and plimsolls, leather lace-up shoes or sandals and a gas mask box

We are requesting a voluntary contribution of £5.55 per child towards the cost of the visit. There is no obligation to make a contribution and, if you choose not to, your child will not be treated any differently. If we do not receive enough contributions, however, future trips and events for this year group may not be able to go ahead. You may make your voluntary payment online via the Tucasi payment system.
