The KS1 winners were **SAPPHIRES!**

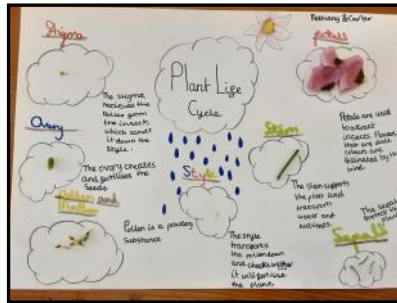
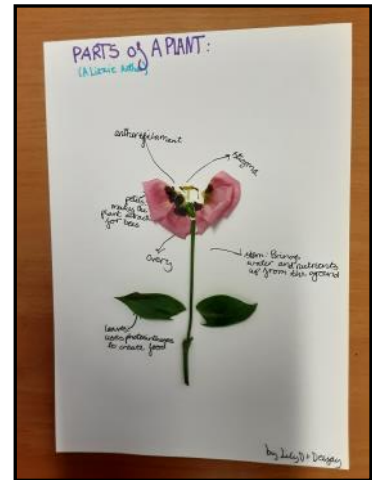
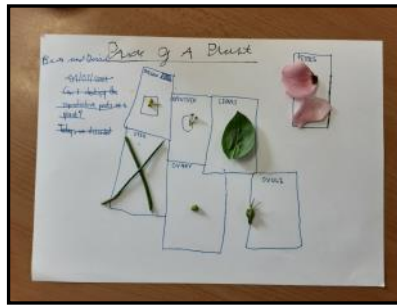
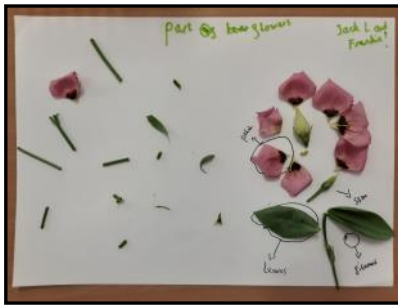
