


In Phonics, we will continue to learn p the phase 2 sounds. We will start with n, m, d, g and continue to finish learning all of the phase 2 sounds this half term. We will focus on blending sounds to read a word. We will be using our sound knowledge to start writing initial sounds, words and captions. Look out for a video coming soon to Tapestry to support with phonics at home. A phonics workshop will follow later in the term.

In PE, we will control to develop co-ordination and control in our movements. We will focus on dance, and begin to perform a sequence of movements.

We will be reading, retelling and writing about the story 'Whatever Next'. As well as this, we will be reading a range of 'Out of this World' themed books.



We will be learning about bullying, what it looks like, how it makes others feel and how it is different to falling out with your friends.
