Learning Objectives	Example Questions
26. Round numbers up to 100 to the nearest 10	What is 16 to the nearest 10? What is 89 to the nearest 100? What could this number be: <input type="text"/> to the nearest 10 = 60
27. Recall the doubles of all numbers to 20	What is double 9? $19 \times 2 =$ Double <input type="text"/> = 36

Learning Objectives	Example Questions
28. Recognise odd and even numbers	<p>Is 29 odd or even?</p> <p>Write an even number between 27 and 35.</p> <p>Which is the first even number immediately before 48?</p>
29. Compare numbers from 0 to 100 using $<$, $>$ and $=$ signs	<p>Compare numbers from 0 to 100 using $<$, $>$ and $=$ signs:</p> <p>e.g. 27 <input type="text"/> 76, 45 <input type="text"/> 46, 78 <input type="text"/> 78</p>
30. Recognise the value of each digit in a 2-digit number (tens, units)	<p>How many units are there in 37?</p> <p>How many tens are there in 45?</p> <p><input type="text"/> + 6 = 96</p>
